Anna Jarvis established the first Mother's Day in 1908. She intended this day to commemorate her own mother's lifelong efforts to organize mothers for peace, lower infant mortality rates, and help heal the wounds of the Civil War. By 1914, so many cities and states observed the holiday that President Woodrow Wilson made it official. Anna Jarvis quickly saw her day becoming commercialized, with the focus on gift-giving. She Mother's believed Day should be spent enjoying time with your own mother.

Calling back to the original spirt of the holiday, the library is the perfect place to connect with vour loved ones.
