## On Your Mark, Get Set, Read!

Summer reading is coming! This year, you are invited to explore sports and fitness as we present "On Your Mark, Get Set, Read" for children age 3 and up. We will also offer a "Little Runners Club" for infants and toddlers through age 2 and a "Get in the Game - Read" reading club for teens. Adults are invited to "Exercise Your Mind - Read!"

The summer reading program is both fun and practical. Studies have shown that children who read over the summer can actually improve their reading skills. And of course, there is no assigned reading so kids are free to read books

that appeal to them, be it fiction or nonfiction. Audio books can be counted, too, as well as books presented at storytime. During the 2015 summer reading program, 1,546 children, teens, and adults read a total of 30,985 books. A total of 10,672 people attended 515 programs at the library. How will we do this year?

In addition to reading books to earn prizes, participants will have the opportunity to attend other activities planned at the library. These will include a wide variety of programs that are both fun and educational, including hands-on workshops, physical

challenges, STEM projects, crafts, storytime, and much more! Music, magic shows, animals, contests, and prize drawings will all be part of the fun. See the calendar of events for the complete schedule. All programs are free of charge.

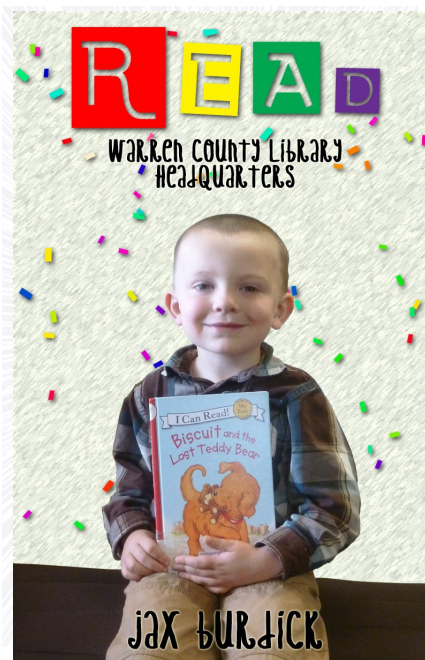

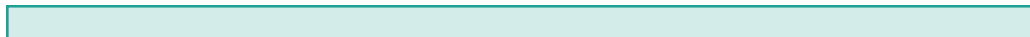
