Bugs—A very special program for kids

Bugs in Your Library is a hands-on STEM program brought to you in partnership with the California Academy of Sciences and the National Girls Collaborative Project. Children ages 10 to 14 will become Citizen Scientists while participating in the project - they will create hypotheses, collect data, make observations and discover the bugs in and around our libraries. Through the use of the application iNaturalist these observations will be submitted to citizen scientists and research scientists worldwide to better understand our local insect ecosystem and cre-

ate plans of action to protect and evolve the system.

The program is twelve sessions long and will be run over the course of six weekly meetings at all four of library branches from mid-January through February. It is imperative that a good-faith effort to attend all six sessions is made by all participants. The California Academy of Sciences has asked that in exchange for providing the curriculum and scientific supplies valued at \$5,000, we collect attendance and survey the children on knowledge and interest of STEM fields prior to and after the pro-

gramming. This is valuable data for the California Academy of the Sciences, as it allows them to better program to continue to build a strong foundation of STEM interest in our children.

This is a fantastic program for everyone involved - your children will grow with a strong STEM identity, our library system will be able to continue our commitment to providing STEAM outreach to Warren county children and it helps to ensure our community continues to have a robust and diverse natural ecosystem.
