## Summer 101

Keep your kids learning all summer with classes at our library.

Prevent summer reading loss (also known as the “summer slide”) by enrolling your children in our reading program. Kids will be challenged to “Build a better world” and to set reading goals for the summer. Weekly incentives and prizes help to keep kids motivated to read.

We don’t want the kids to have all the fun, so we have developed a reading program for infants and adults too. The program runs June 19 - August 12. Registration and more information is available at the library.

Make reading an activity for the whole family. Plan visits

to the library, read a book with your child, discuss a book you are reading, or download a free eBook or eAudiobook (from our library of course!). Listen to a book on your next road trip. Listening to a book is not only enjoyable, it also develops reading comprehension and vocabulary, critical listening and can introduce kids to books above their reading level.

Learning is always fun at the library. During the summer we offer a wide variety of classes and special events. This summer we have classes on coding and engineering, butterflies and bats, gardening and space. Visit our library website to check out our online calendar of events and classes and don’t forget to register for classes...

we don’t want you to miss any of the fun.

Take your kids somewhere educational...and don’t spend a dime on admission. Borrow a museum pass (<http://www.warrenlib.org/node/1918>) and spend the day at the Intrepid Sea, Air & Space Museum, the Guggenheim or other museum. Museum passes are provided through the fundraising efforts of the Friends of the Library (Northeast and Headquarters Branch) and Library Trustees (Catherine Dickson Hofman Branch).
