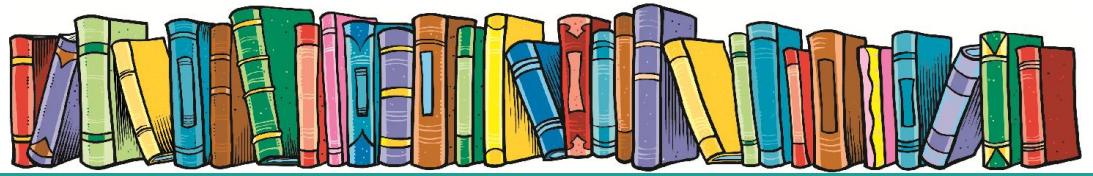

Check-out . . .

the Internet

We have offered free access to the Internet through our library computers and WiFi network, however starting in September members can check-out the Internet for use at home.

The library will start lending mobile hotspots and tablets. These devices work off the same network as mobile phones so you can use them even if you don't have the internet at home.

The mobile hotspots and tablets have unlimited data plans. However, there is a monthly cap on high-speed data. You will be able to connect up to five mobile devices to the hotspot.

Library members will be able to check out these devices for 28 days and can renew the devices two additional times if there is no one waiting to borrow the item.

"These mobile devices will

allow people to use the internet from home. If you are unemployed, money can be tight, and people cancel their internet service. People still need the internet to search and apply for jobs, and kids need it for school work." says Library Director, Maureen Wilkinson.

"Warren County has areas with limited choices for traditional internet service and dead areas for mobile networks. These devices will let people experiment with the service before committing to it."

"I attended a conference earlier this year and met staff from a non-profit group called "EveryoneOn" that works towards eliminating the digital divide by making high-speed, low-cost Internet service and computers, and free digital literacy courses accessible to all unconnected Americans. I was able to discuss issues re-



lated to connectivity in our county, and they put me in touch with a vendor that offered discounted mobile service and equipment that we could lend to the public."

"This new service complements our existing technology services and computer classes, provides access to our online resources, and supports participants in our NJ Career Connections program."
