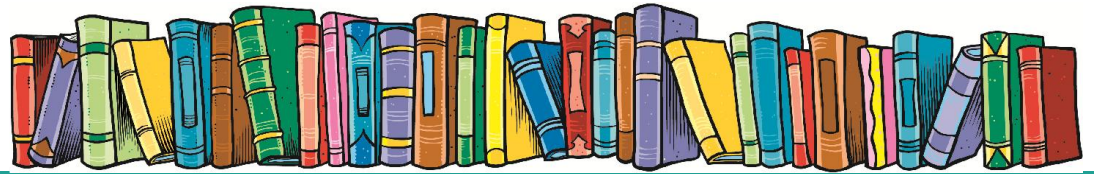

Warren County Library's Science Action Club (SAC) received a shout-out in the SAC newsletter from the California Academy of Sciences for their podcast on bats.

SAC Activity Leader Ryan Somelofske at the Warren County Library in New Jersey shared this story in their Facebook group: "At

the end of Bird Scouts the young scientists in one of our clubs had a lot of questions on how bats can fly if they're not birds. We reconvened during summer and researched, wrote, and recorded a podcast answering all the questions we had about bats!"
