GOT QUESTIONS?

Are you Open? How can I borrow an eBook or stream a movie on Hoopla? How can I tell when my library books are due back? How can I get NJ tax forms?

Beginning in March, you can ask us questions from your computer, tablet or phone. Click the green "Ask a Question" tab on the right side of our website. Your click will open a pop-up window where you can type your question and send it to library staff by email, instant message or chat (chat is not available outside of library operating hours). Answers will be delivered to you by the same method (email, instant message or chat) used when sending the question. Staff from all branches will be monitoring this service and responding to your questions. Questions received when we are closed are answered the next business day.

So ask us questions... we're listening.

10 things you may not know about our library.....

1. We circulated 490,924 physical items and 27,272 electronic items books and media in 2017
2. The annual number of books moving between our branches to fill member requests is equal to the collection at our Catherine Dickson Hofman Branch.
3. Our branches offers free WiFi and wireless printing.
4. Headquarters Branch has a scanner for public use. Your completed scans can be emailed, saved to a thumb drive or delivered to your phone. The same machine can also fax documents (\$1.00 per page).
5. Our online calendar can email program reminders. You can also subscribe to get an email notification for similar programs (ie. Craft, STEM programs).
6. Warren County Library received 5 awards from the New Jersey Library Association since 2011.
7. "New Book Alerts" is our weekly e-newsletter listing items we purchased the previous week. You can subscribe to the newsletter or view it online. (There is a link at the top of our catalog page) Don't forget to click "check catalog" to go to our catalog and place a hold on items.
8. View your library account (link is at top of our website) to keep track of what you have borrowed and renew your items.
9. Too many books to read right now? Going on vacation? You can suspend your holds on library items through your library account. While the hold is suspended you will continue to move up the holds list, but will be held at the number 2 position until you make the hold active.
10. Want to create something on a 3D printer? We accept print jobs by email. See our website for more information (under Adults tab).
